## Appendix II – Index of Key Individuals

This index includes individuals whose actions directly influenced factory founding, technology, organisation or consolidation.

**Bagge, Jonas Samuel (1803-1870)** – Chemist and industrial entrepreneur, founder of J.S. Bagge & Co, pioneer of early organised match-related chemical production in Sweden

**Bratt, Charles E. (1840-1911)** – Co-founder and director, Vulcan Match Factory, Tidaholm. Co-founder Trollhättan Match Factory, Trollhättan.

**Friis, Carl G. (1817-?)** – Founder, Malmros Match Factory

**Kreuger, Ivar (1880-1932)** – Financier, founder of Svenska Tändsticks AB

**Lagerman, Alexander (1836-1904)** – Mechanical engineer and inventor

**Lundström, Carl Frans (1823-1917)** – Co-founder, organiser, and industrial leader

**Lundström, Johan Edvard (1815-1888)** – Industrialist, pioneer of safety match manufacturing

**Malmros, J (1814 - ?)** – Founder, Malmros Match Factory

**Pasch, Gustaf Erik (1788-1862)** – Chemist and inventor of the safety match principle
